The weather this winter has been very pleasant and the snow has been reasonable. The lack of salt on the roads has meant driving the LBC is less of a death sentence on old English steel.

I've had the TR4 since 2003 and it was my daily driver for 2 1/2 years—summer, winter, spring and fall. The salt did its damage to the sheet metal in particular. Fortunately the TRs are body on frame rather than monocoque like the MGBs. Less structural damage from rust that way.

Those years as a daily driver in SLC plus the decades prior to that left the sheet metal in dire need of repair and TLC.

The result was a strip down to bare metal, replacement of holes and lace with new metal and a repaint from white to red.
