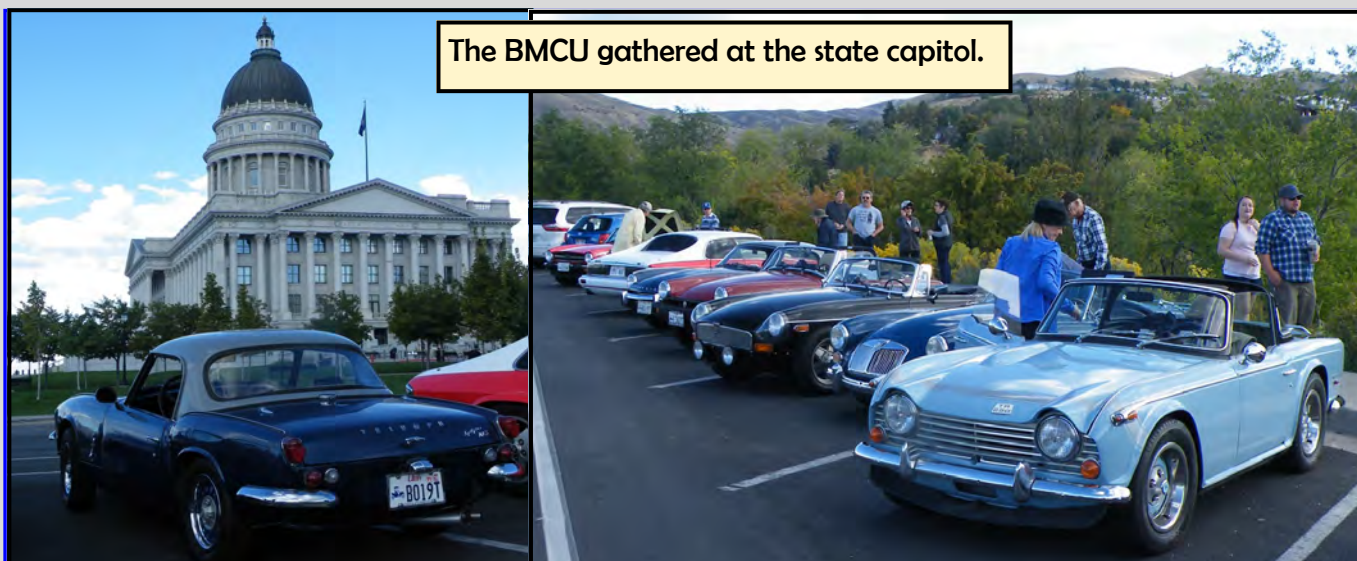

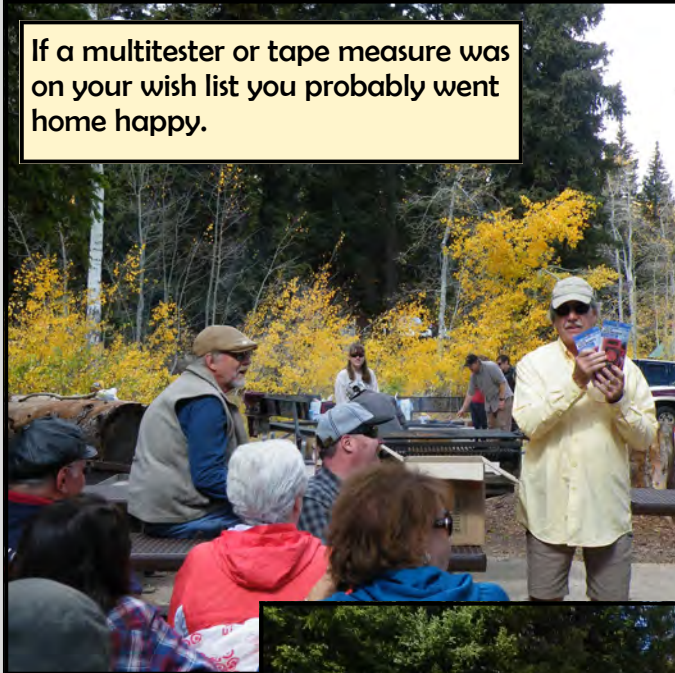


## Picnic at 8900'

Smores hit the spot for desert.



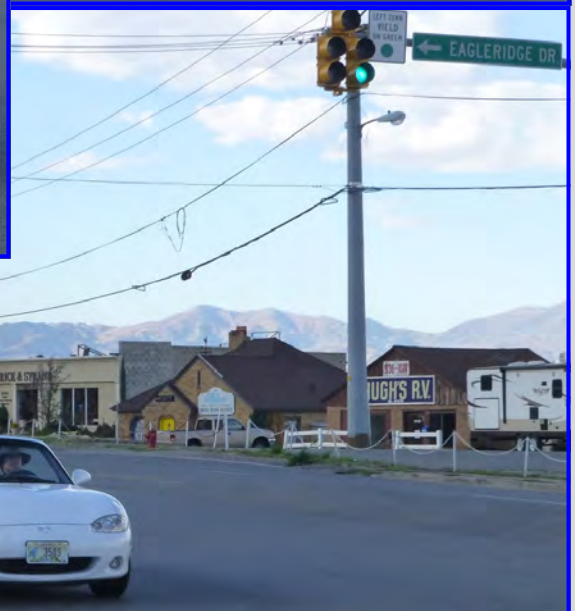
There was a large picnic area with tables. Pat Rich went up early and saved a space, started the fire and had everything ready and waiting.
