Business was taken care of with the usual reports from the Exchequer and Membership board members. We still have some money and our membership grew by 60 last season.


Thank you to the Board for presenting the Appreciation plaques to Jill and myself. That was a very nice gesture. The plaques will be placed in our office where we can see them every day.

#### **BMCU & British Field Day**

The British Motor Club of Utah has been involved with British Field Day since it's inception on May 23, 1992. From it's meager beginnings to the present large size, the Club members have enjoyed displaying their vehicles. The growth has allowed many people to see and enjoy our cars. Much has evolved during this run and it's now time that what started as a British Motor Club event is now exclusively an event organized and run by the Liberty Wells Community Council, not the British Motor Club of Utah.

The BMCU Board feels that the British Field Day is a great place to show your British car. As with the other car shows in the area i.e. The Peach Days and The Festival of Speed and others, if you want to show your car, by all means do so. The BMCU is not against any of the many shows and we encourage you to attend them if you would like to.

Liberty Park has been a wonderful location for BFD. It has, however, in the past few years, been having local problems with the homeless, people going through the area shouting profanities and others claiming rights to the section set aside for the Liberty Wells Community Council. The autocross that has been a staple of the British Field Day, although a great crowd attraction, creates a liability that the British Motor Club of Utah does not wish to bear. The public thinks that this is a BMCU event, when it is not.

For these reasons, the Board unanimously agreed that steps should be taken to make certain that the ownership, responsibility and liability of the British Field Day, falls on the Liberty Wells Community Council. The BMCU name should not be included in any advertising. The British Field Day is not a British Motor Club of Utah event.

The British Motor Club of Utah is a driving club, not a show club. We have been supportive of the BFD, but no longer do we want our name associated with the event.

We believe that the BMCU members who want to continue to show their cars at the BFD, should do so as should anyone else owning a British vehicle. The British Motor Club of Utah is not associated with the BFD in any way. Individual members are encouraged to show their car(s) if they wish, but they do so as individuals, not representing BMCU.
