Had a check engine light - codes were read, showed lean bank 1 bank 2 code, which google tells me can be "vacuum leaks, dirty or failing mass airflow sensors (MAF), or fuel delivery issues". There was also a minor evap leak code.

These were reset and the check engine light had now gone, although there is an intermittent stability control warning message (not check engine light), that resets on re-starting, but often comes back.

Could do with upper suspension mounts / new front shocks, also has a minor steering rack leak. New battery fitted a couple of weeks ago. So - anyone looking for a winter project? Could be a great opportunity for a club member to get her running right. If anyone has had a hankering for a big cat and is not afraid of some work, message me.
